Email

Used for: all letters that do not require consent or payments and any other information or reminders which makes sense to send out in paper form.

Please can you ensure that we have your correct email address (on Pupil Record Sheet) and that you check your account for any emails from us.

Used for: general information, reminders, diary dates, useful guidance to support your child, past events, emergency information (if appropriate)



Letters:

Used for: all letters that require parental consent and/or payments.

Used for: general information, reminders, events, emergency information (if appropriate)

TXT Round: A texting Program

Used for: Whole school emergencies ONLY.

You do not need to download any particular app; just make sure we have your mobile number (on Pupil Record Sheet) and you would receive a text message with the letters 'BJA' in it, so you know it's from us and not the Infant or Secondary Schools. Every time we use this system, it costs the school – hence we only use it for big emergencies.
