As an Academy we agree that we will:

- Provide a broad, balanced, relevant, stimulating curriculum
- Set regular homework
- Encourage positive attitudes towards learning
- Have high expectations of children
- Help your child to keep themselves safe when using technology
- Keep parents informed about the work children will do and Academy activities through the newsletter and information evenings;
- Provide parents with reports on their children's progress at consultation evenings and at the end of each school year;
- Always respond to parents concerns as professionally as possible within 5 school days;
- Always welcome parents support, interest and involvement in the day- to-day work of the Academy

As parents we agree that we will:

- Ensure regular attendance of our children at the Academy (endeavouring where possible, not to remove children during term time for family holidays);
- Make sure children wear school uniform and have appropriate kit when needed;
- Notify the Academy promptly of reasons for absence;
- Ensure that homework is completed on time and returned to the Academy at the correct time;
- Attend consultation evenings to discuss children's progress with teachers;
- Encourage good behaviour by supporting the Academy's code of conduct;
- Ensure that any photo's/video's that I take of my child during class assemblies/whole school productions etc will only be for personal use;
- Support our children and the Academy with regards to the Academy's code of conduct and rules concerning e-safety.
