These are open activities as the children are free to choose what they do and how they present it, as long as the work is based around the theme “Pirates.” The due date for the 2 tasks to be completed is: Monday 16th July.

Below are some ideas for the three activities your child could undertake:

- A model of a pirate ship
- A biography of a famous pirate
- Write your own sea shanty
- A review of a pirate based book or film
- A treasure map with co-ordinates
- A design of a pirate flag
- An animation about pirates
- Make a telescope
- A 3D treasure island
- Map work about where pirates travelled

These are just some ideas on what your child could do. However, if your child has been inspired by something we have done in class or by something learnt at home it would be fantastic to see them portraying that in their own piece of work.
